General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at facility prior to the children. The purpose was to verify documentation and freely speak to the administrator of the facility. The filing system is organized and complete. The administrator was advised that attendance records only needed to be kept for 1 year. Once the renewal inspection is complete, older attendance records can be discarded. The environment is set up with large learning centres with a variety of materials for the children to play with. This included a book area that had comfortable seating and blankets for the children to use. There was also an area set up with books that the children had made which could be accessed to read by all of the children. A building center, games center, dramatic play area, art, and a physical movement area was also available to the

children.

When it was time, the 3 educators left to meet the buses that come from different schools. Once the children returned, they hung up their bags, washed their hands and proceeded to the tables to eat their snacks. After snack the children sat on the rug in the book area and were given a choice to go outside or to stay inside and do an art activity with one of the educators.

Licensing staff followed the larger group outside and immediately noticed the shade that was put into place. The children have access to a storage shed where there is an abundance of materials for them to play with while outside. It includes, balls, hula hoops, ball gloves, art supplies, board games, to name a few.

The administrator stated that in the summer, they do take the children to the pool for free swim. The ratio is kept at 1 educator to 8 children. As time is limited throughout the school year, the children only swim to take swimming lessons.

The educators have a good rapport with the children. They gently correct more challenging behaviours and the children respond to them in a positive way. The environment was observed a calm and organized with a routine that the children follow and know.
