Monitoring visit performed today.

Upon arrival all children were observed in the outdoor play area. At this time, the Operator is having outdoor renovation work completed. This is all confined to a fenced in play area, however children are inquisitive, so please ensure you can keep the gate locked at all times so children cannot easily open and enter. Though I overheard the construction worker today say 'please close the gate' when a child tried to enter where he was working. I would also request that the work trailer have caution tape around it so children are not running in and around it. Caution tape could be attached to fences on both sides. With appropriate supervision children would be advised not to enter that area of the play space. If construction work is going to take place during operating hours, the work truck should be parked well outside the play area as the driveway is located in the middle of the 2 play spaces.

Administrative records were reviewed and attendance was being recorded, however as noted above there was confusion, as some children were not on the attendance record that were in the classrooms. Be sure to add both first and last names on the record. Educators should always be documenting arrivalsand departures even

when leaving for short periods of time. For example if a child leaves with a parent to go to an appointment etc. and when they return, sign them back in on the attendance record. The educator updated the attendance record during my visit.

Children were also observed moving about back and forth between classrooms and cubby areas. Educators should be supervising their group of children at all times and ensure they remain in their own classrooms and cubby areas. I would recommend that cubby area near each classroom be used for that group of children in that classroom. This would eleviate children moving back and forth between rooms and aid in supervision. I would also recommend having eating utensils in each classroom so children have access to their own cutlery. All children were observed going indoors and washing hands for lunch then settling into some quiet activities after lunch - sand table, loose parts, kitchen centre, magnetic blocks, drawing, watching a movie, reading etc. After an hour, the educator provided lots of transition time and announced to clean up as they were going outdoors for outside play. Children were reminded to fill up their water bottles, put on sunscreen etc. Appropriate child guidance was observed. Educators were observed speaking to children in a kind manner and opening packages for children at lunch.
