General Comments						
Upon arrival of the licensing staff to conduct the annual renewal inspection, school age children were observed engaging in outdoor play in the designated play area. Several children had brought remote-controlled (RC) cars from home and were actively playing with them. Others were engaged in various activities, including building structures in the sandbox, using the playground equipment, and climbing trees with multiple low hanging branches. Educators were present and attentive, observing the children as they climbed and providing guidance on safe climbing limits. Additionally, some children were seen playing with hockey sticks, and on the wooden beams. The outdoor play area also included a gaga ball pit and featured ample natural shade provided by the surrounding trees. Featured was also ropes for children to swing and climb on. Ten minutes before lunch time an educator advised the children that they will need to clean up outside and prepare to eat their lunch indoors. Transition into lunch was smooth, children grabbed their water bottles that were on the deck outdoors, and their lunch boxes from their designated hooks. After washing their hands, children ate at the table.						
Indoors, the play area included a reading corner, craft corner, dolls and dollhouses, toy cars and animals, a dramatic play area, and some costumes. The walls displayed a "Joke of the Day" and "Artwork of the Week," along with other projects the children had recently completed. The theme of the week was also posted, this week being "Messy Week".						
Staff and child files were verified. A reminder was provided to ensure that the current yearly license certificate is prominently displayed. Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
