General Comments

Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children were engaged in free play. There was no school today and a lower number of children were in attendance. The children were playing with magnets, dolls, and some were doing crafts. The educators were attentive and engaging in conversation with the children. In one room, some of the children started playing with marbles and a track. An educator helped some of the children take out paint supplies and the children sat down to paint. In the other room, some children were making a craft, others were playing with barbies and some with Minecraft blocks. An educator was observed sitting with some of the children and engaging in conversation. Some of the children took out some Kinetic sand and cars, making hills and tracks. An educator started playing a matching game with some of the children. The children were observed drawing on a white board and the educator proposed a game of Hangman.

The children started cleaning up as the educators started heating up lunches. The children washed their hands and sat at the table to eat. The educators were sitting with the children as they ate. An educator was heard asking the children how their weekend was and what they had done. After lunch, the children put their lunch boxes away and returned to their play. A group of children continued playing with the Kinetic sand, and others with Legos and magnets. An educator sat at a table with some of the children to play a board game.

The indoor environment was organized, and materials were accessible to the children. Various resources were available, such as art supplies, dolls, Legos, magnets, beads, Kinetic sand, playdough, books, mini hockey, and a kitchen. The rooms were decorated with the children's artwork, "All About Me" sheets, and various pictures of recent activities. Child files were checked and contained required documents. Only positive child guidance was observed.
