General Comments							
Two groups of children were outside playing today when I arrived for today's monitoring visit. Children were observed participating in a variety of different play at this time, from playing on climbing dome, playing tag on the climbing structure, basketball, Beyblades, at the mud kitchen, etc. The children who wanted to play Beyblades were observed being creative as they were constructing their own arena out of large Lego blocks for their Beyblades while they were waiting for their educator to be able to go inside and bring one out for them. Certain children were asking if they could color, the educator promptly went inside to get some coloring material for them so they could color/draw outside.							
Children wanted to have snack outside. Educators were observed sanitizing all tables and ensure the children sanitized their hands before and after they ate.							
All educators were observed interacting with children at time of visit. When redirection and gentle reminders were needed, the educators were observed ensuring they were always down at the children's level when speaking with them.							
When the older children arrived from school, they went directly inside. Educator offered the children the opportunity to have snack or play in centers in the room. Once snack was over, and the children had a sufficient time to play, they went outside to play for the remainder of the afternoon.							
All toxic products were locked during time of inspection. There were keys left in the lock of the red cleaning supplies cabinet in the back room at time of inspection. Please ensure that once cabinets are locked, that the Page 1 of 2
