Monitoring Inspection:

Infant Room:

Children engaged in sensory play this morning. Educators have added a variety of materials to the environment that support the children's interest in sharks. The environment is set in an inviting way that allows children to explore and play in each interest centre. Educators observed expanding on the children's language today. A child showed their educator a toy shark and said "shark" and the educator responded by saying "yes, a purple shark".

Twos Room:

The children in this room were observed exploring a variety of dramatic play materials this morning. The educators had created a doctors office within the environment for the children to explore. Many positive interactions were observed between the educators and children as they engaged in dramatic play. Children were observed checking the dolls heartbeat, temperatures and putting bandages on injuries.

Two/Threes Room:

The children in this room were getting ready to go outside and enjoy the sun and snow during the visit today. Many positive interactions were observed during this transition time. Educators were observed encouraging children to try and get their outdoor clothing on independently.

Evidence of purposeful planning is well documented throughout the room. The children are currently interested in farm animals and airport. Educators have added materials into the environment to expand on these interests.
