<p>Follow Up Inspection:</p> <p>Two/Threes Room: Transition times in this group appear to be a challenging time for both, children and educators. Transition times must be purposefully planned to help alleviate behaviour challenges. Example - invitations set up, involving the children in the clean up of lunch and set up of cots, story time, etc.</p> <p>Broken and worn materials have now been removed from environments, however these materials have not been replaced. Example: Dramatic play food, puzzles and play kitchen. Ensure materials that are frequently used and become worn are replaced.</p>
