General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

Infant Room:

Children and educators observed during meal time, transition time and before rest. Educators were sitting with the children at meal time engaging in conversation and encouraging them to eat independently. The learning environment is set up with a variety of interesting materials for the children to explore. The children's current interest in rolling, pushing and pulling is evident through materials and documentation added to the environment.

Two's Room:

Children and educators observed during play, rest time, transitions and outdoor play. Documentation is posted throughout the room supporting the children's interests and learning. A variety of materials have been added to the dramatic play area that have expanded on the interest in Ambulances.

Two/Three Room:

Children and educators observed during outdoor play, transition time, meal time and rest. Educators observed sitting with children at lunch engaging in meaningful conversations. Documentation is posted throughout the environment supporting the children's learning and interests. Materials have been added to the environment that support interests in cooking and birds.

Hand washing routines observed.

Children were greeted upon arrival in a way that welcomed them to child care for the day.
