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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including open ended art, dramatic play, outdoor play, stories, and fine motor activities. The children spent time outdoors this morning exploring the fresh snow and materials in the outdoor play area.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (water animals, food, construction, and farm). Documentation includes connections to the NB Curriculum Framework. Real-life materials have been added to the kitchen area within the Infant Room.</p> <p>The infants were observed during lunch time; educators assisted them with feeding and encouraged them to feed themselves independently.</p> <p>Nap time was observed today. The environments are dim, and educators put soft music on to ensure the environment is relaxing for children. The children's cots are set-up with bedding and are situated at an adequate distance apart. Educators observed comforting children as they settle in for nap.</p> <p>Tomato soup, egg salad and turkey sandwiches, crackers, bananas with milk were served for lunch. Handwashing routines were observed before mealtimes. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (4) review was completed. Ensure the administrator's ECE certificate is added to staff file. A Change in Service Application for change in administrator is to be submitted to QA Monitor.</p>
