Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a bottle of Advil and Aller Aid stored in an educator's cubby. This observation was immediately brought to the attention of the administrator. The administrator promptly removed the Tylenol and secured it in a locked storage area in accordance with safety protocols. The administrator also indicated that moving forward, a lockbox will be purchased for each room to provide staff with a secure location to store any personal medication, ensuring compliance with health and safety regulations. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor was on-site to conduct the renewal inspection. Throughout the visit, child-to-staff ratios were maintained in accordance with regulations. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed various daily routines and activities, including outdoor and indoor play, lunchtime, and nap time. A discussion took place regarding children playing in stagnant water. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the administrator that stagnant water was observed in the outdoor play area, where children were seen playing. As soon as this was brought to the attention of the educator, the area with stagnant water was immediately blocked off. The administrator advised that additional holes would be made in the tires where the water collects to allow for proper drainage and prevent future accumulation. The Quality Assurance Monitor also inquired about the availability of outdoor play equipment. The administrator stated that each classroom has a basket containing balls and skipping ropes and other outdoor materials. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended reminding educators to consistently bring these materials outside during outdoor play. It was noted that only one ball was present in the playground, despite approximately 30 children being outside at the time.
