### General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the Educators were waiting for the children at the bus stop. The children were greeted as they got off the bus. Once both busses had arrived, the Educators and children were observed walking back to the facility.

Once inside, children hung up their bookbags, got lunch boxes, water bottles and washed their hands to prepare for lunch. Children had a few minutes to play as they waited for hot lunch to be ready for pick up. One Educator was observed bringing 2 children with her to collect hot lunch, ensuring ratio was maintained. Once the Educator returned with hot lunch, the children sat down and began eating. As the children ate, an Educator went over the plan for the afternoon. Tables were cleaned, floors were swept, and tabletop activities were set up once lunch time was finished. Throughout the afternoon children were observed playing board games, building Lego creations, reading books and making keychains with Perler beads.

Later in the afternoon, the children packed their belongings and got ready to go outside to end the day. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's visit. Educators were observed helping friends during a small disagreement. Positive words of encouragement were heard, and problem-solving skills were used. Several positive changes have been made in the facility. Large webbing filled with pictures, quotes from children and learning stories were posted on the walls throughout the classroom. Child profiles were reviewed during today's Monitoring Inspection. Files were organized and contained all required documents. Fire drills and first aid checklists were observed and are up to date.
