<p>General Comments</p> <p>A follow up to the renewal inspection was conducted today. All outstanding orders for compliance were completed and the facility is recommended for license renewal.</p> <p>Discussed with educators in the room creating an engaging/inviting environment based on the interest of the children. Discussed asking the school-age children what they would like to have in their environments (not electronics/video games), then document those ideas and purchase the equipment necessary to achieve their ideas.</p> <p>When some of the children were asked, ideas such as different clay and small white boards were shared by them. When asked what would you create with clay, the school-age children replied animals, people.</p> <p>Also discussed with educators to post on one of the white boards asking the children to add to the white boards their ideas to enhance their space.</p> <p>Creating a school-age program with ideas and materials that the children actually want to interact and engage with will create a place they can call their "own". This will also help with boredom and behaviours.</p> <p>Also discussed electronics such as old DVD/VCR players and toasters (cords removed) and screw drivers, letting the children take these apart to explore the inner workings.</p>
