<p>General Comments</p> <p>Follow Up Inspection:</p> <p>Children's portfolios have been updated with photos and documentation that highlights their learning and interests.</p> <p>The main preschool room (right side) has been decluttered and rearranged to allow children and educators to flow freely throughout the learning environment.</p> <p>During inspection it was observed that some educators were not aware of how many children were present. Educators knew their ratio number and how many staff were required however, they did not know how many children were in attendance when asked by QAM. Ensure all staff are aware of how many children are within the facility at all times. Educators must communicate these numbers to each staff member arriving to work/covering breaks. Discussed with operator during inspection.</p> <p>Operator stated that two animal habitats had been removed from play areas. QA Monitor discussed plans moving forward and left some ideas on how to create more space within smaller room (left side). Operator stated that some more animals will be removed and there will not be anymore added. QA Monitor counted 20 aquariums/habitats during inspection this morning.</p>
