Comments: Storage closet where toxic products are kept to be locked with a secure lock. Lock that is on door is for "home use only". Extra liquid hand soap stored in drawer in bathroom. Products indicates "keep out of the reach of children". This was stored in closet during inspection.

<p>Renewal Inspection:</p> <p>A wide variety of materials are available for the children to interact and engage with. Program began week of November 18th and children have settled into their environment and are interacting with their peers and educators.</p>

General Comments

Children observed making playdough with educators then exploring with it using a variety of cutters, scissors etc.

It is great to see the children and educators singing songs during their play and learning. Discussed with educators that children must participate in a minimum of 1/2 hour of outside play each day where current program is less than 4 hours in length.
