General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators were observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including dramatic play, art, cooperative games and fine motor activities. The PreK children were exploring the learning environment freely. A small group of children and their educator were playing Hot Potato and doing the Robot Dance on the rug in the reading area. Another group was cooking and serving each other pretend food in the dramatic play kitchen. One child was quietly exploring a switchboard at the table, they experimented with the switches, buttons and keys that turned on small lights.

In response to recommendations left on the last Monitoring Inspection report an indicator has been added to the weekly menu to show which week of meals are being served and the most current Monitoring Inspection is now posted on the Parent Board.

The dramatic play costume stand is accumulating sand, food crumbs and clutter. To be cleaned and set-up in a way that invites children to engage in dramatic play. Recommendations were left with administrator to have materials added to the easel. Example: whiteboard markers, chalk, paint, magnets, etc.

Handwashing routines were observed after messy play and during washroom routines.
Monthly fire drills are documented.
Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
New staff file (3) review was completed; all required documents are in place. All Criminal Record Checks are now on file from a New Brunswick police jurisdiction.
Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (3/3) requirement.
