General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including sensory opportunities, matching games, dramatic play and open-ended art. A small group of children were digging for bugs in soil, an educator had set-up an invitation in the Tuff Tray with toy bugs hidden in the soil, a variety of tools were accessible for digging and scooping. Two children were participating in a bug scavenger hunt throughout the learning environment. Another small group of children were exploring painting on a chalkboard with paint brushes and water; they discussed how the water left marks, how it dried up and they could start again.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environment that support the children's current interests (bugs, babies, flowers, and plants).

In response to the recommendation noted at the last Monitoring Inspection, the dramatic play costume stand has been cleaned, and the dramatic play materials have been organized and displayed in a way that invites the children to participate in pretend play. The easel has also been set-up with art materials and activities.

Handwashing routines were observed after messy play and during washroom routines.
Monthly fire drills are documented.
Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection.
New staff file (2) review was completed; all required documents are in place.
Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (3/3) requirement.
