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**General Comments**

Licensing Staff arrived at Happy Faces Home Childcare to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, all children were still napping. Licensing Staff sat with the Operator engaging in conversation about the children's interest and areas in the home the Operator would like to work on next. Once the children woke up, diapers were changed, hands were washed and the children sat at the kitchen table together as the Operator prepared afternoon snack.

Today the children had carrots, cheese and crackers at snack time. The children talked about their summer plans as they ate. Some children were eager to tell their peers about upcoming camping trips to Yogi Bear Jellystone Park while others explained they were excited to go to the beach and collect shells. The children took their time eating snack before packing up their belongings and preparing to go outside.

Once bug spray had been applied and the children got their outdoor shoes and hat on, they lined up at the back door to go play outside. In the backyard there's a large shed full of play materials that the children have full access to. The shed was well organized; all bins were labelled and clear so the children could see what was inside. Some children chose to play with dump trucks, bowls and shovels, scooping the rocks into the trucks and making large piles while others played on the swing set.

Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The children appeared to be familiar and comfortable with the Operator and the daily routine. Attendance records and daily information sheets are being completed. The families were greeted at end of day and children were signed out.
