The tire climbing structure has several bolts sticking out which will need to be covered or removed. S hooks on tire walking swing structure must be covered. One of the slides is cracked at the top and must be repaired. A meter long rusted metal spike was found on a small table in the play area. This must be removed. Until these items are repaired children are not to use structures. In infant play area the play kitchen has standing water that must be emptied out before play. A large tire also contains standing water which must be emptied. A large cardboard box was found in the play area which appeared to be used for an activity but must be removed as it has been rained on, and is soggy. One side of the infant play area is enclosed by a small shed. The siding on this shed is broken in one place and poses a risk as it is both sharp and breaking off.
