Comments: Inspector was only able to verify the professional learning hours of 1 staff member. Administrator must ensure that the proof of completion of the professional learning hours are accessible during the 2nd follow up inspection.			
12(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may be, and a check with the Department of Social Development is conducted on each individual before he or she becomes a staff member.	12(2)	Jan 18, 2024	
Comments: A staff member has not obtained a criminal record / vulnerable sector check and a Social Development check prior to employment. This staff was asked to leave the premises immediately. The staff is not permitted to return on-site until all required checks have been completed and are clear of contravention. A copy of the checks must be provided to the inspector and placed in the staff's file.			
21 The daily activities of a licensed facility shall be purposely planned in advance and documented and shall respond to the capabilities, needs and interests of each child.	21	Jan 01, 2024	
Comments: Inspector was able to see programming of the daily activities in 4 out of 5 groups. Administrator must ensure that daily programming is documented.

Comments: 1 out of 5 audited children's records is missing the consent to bathe the child in the event of illness or soiled clothing. Administrator must ensure that all required information is indicated in each child's record.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Dec 20, 2023	
Comments: Inspector observed that there was no rusted materials in the outdoor play area. However, Inspector observed patches of ice on the wooden platform in the infant play area. Administrator must ensure that there is no ice in the outdoor play area, in order for it to remain safe and free of hazards.

Comments: Inspector observed no broken materials in the indoor play area. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, Inspector found Vim, Cascade and antibacterial cleaner in the kitchen underneath the sink. Administrator must ensure that these toxic products are placed under lock and key.

Comments: The diaper changing procedures have been posted. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector observed that the license number and the child's departure time was not indicated on a Management of potential illness form. This information was added immediately. Deficiency is now compliant			
46(3) If consent is oral under subsection (2), the operator of a licensed facility shall require the parent or guardian to give a written acknowledgement when the child is picked up at the licensed facility that acetaminophen was administered with their consent.	46(3)	Dec 18, 2023	Jan 09, 2024
Comments: Inspector was able to verify that parents provide written confirmation upon picking up their child that they are aware that acetaminophen was provided to their child. Deficiency is now compliant			
48(5) If more than one bottle-fed infant is receiving services at a licensed facility, the operator shall ensure that each bottle is (a) labelled with the child's name, (b) used only for the intended child.	48(5)	Dec 20, 2023	Jan 09, 2024
Comments: The infant bottles are labelled with the children's names. Deficiency is now compliant			
50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child involved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.	50(2)	Dec 18, 2023	Jan 09, 2024
Comments: All verified incident logs contain the parents signature. Deficiency is now compliant
