Comments: Inspector observed a rest mat blocking the gate to enter the classroom. This was addressed with the educator, as traffic areas cannot be blocked. The mat was moved during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Dec 20, 2023	Jan 22, 2024
Comments: Inspector did not observe ice in the infant play area. Deficiency is now compliant			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Dec 18, 2023	Jan 22, 2024
Comments: A lock has been added to the cabinet where the toxic products are kept. The cook was in the kitchen during the inspection and confirmed to the inspector that this is locked every time they leave the kitchen. Deficiency is now compliant			
42(1) Smoking, within the meaning of the Smoke-free Places Act, is prohibited during operating hours on the premises of a licensed facility, including in the outdoor play area, during outings and while transporting the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	42(1)	Jan 22, 2024

Comments: Inspector saw an educator smoking in the parking lot of the facility. Smoking is prohibited during operating hours. Administrator must ensure that a follow-up is done regarding this.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Jan 22, 2024	
Comments: Inspector observed 1 educator with a group of 5 infants at the end of the rest period. 3 of the infants were not sleeping or resting quietly on their mats. As the children were up and playing, a 2nd educator must be in the room. The 2nd educator arrived shortly after.  A discussion was had between the Inspector and the Administrator regarding supervision concerns. Inspector observed a child trying to leave a classroom. Inspector had to prompt an educator to let them know that the child was trying to leave the room. Inspector also shared concerns regarding supervision while the children are using the bathroom. Administrator must ensure that this is addressed, and that adequate supervision is provided at all times.
