Comments: Administrator has not yet received proof of enrollment. Proof must be provided to the Inspector once it is received.

Comments: Administrator indicates that this Regulation will be discussed during next week's staff meeting. Administrator must advise Inspector once it has been addressed with all educators that smoking is not permitted on the premises of the facility.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Jan 22, 2024	Jan 26, 2024
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, Inspector observed an educator with 4 infants in their care. 2 infants are resting in the designated rest area and 2 infants are awake in the classroom. As this does not respect ratio, this was addressed with the administrator. Administrator immediately entered the classroom to ensure that ratio is respected. A conversation was had with the administrator and the educator regarding the physical checks that must occur every 15 minutes for the children who are resting in the designated rest area. Administrator is aware of their responsibility regarding this. Deficiency is now compliant
