The facility has a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for toxic products, chemical							
products and cleaning supplies. The cleaning supplies and toxic products that are stored in the kitchen are also locked and inaccessible to children. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe indoor play time, lunch and transition to outdoor play.
