Time will be provided to test strategies and methods that the operator will choose to adapt in their daily practice.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor invites the operator to contact their Early Learning Consultant to receive more resources regarding purposeful planning.</p>

<p>Monitoring inspection conducted.</p> <p>At the time of the visit, the following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Ratio, supervision and maximum number of children- If all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility- Daily activities- Storage space <p>The ratio was respected at the time of the inspection.</p> <p>The facility has a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies. The cleaning supplies and toxic products that are stored in the kitchen are also locked and inaccessible to children.</p> <p>During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe indoor play time, lunch and transition to outdoor play.</p>
