Comments: The inspector verified that daily activities were intentionally planned and documented for each age group. Two of the four groups did not demonstrate consistent purposeful planning and documentation. An email has been sent to the ELC consultant to offer support to these groups in improving daily activities and documentation. The operator must ensure that the daily activities in a licensed facility are intentionally planned in advance, documented, and responsive to the capabilities, needs, and interests of each child.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (c) permitting the administration of medication in the circumstances set out in section 46.	27(c)	Dec 17, 2025	
Comments: Inspector reviewed 15 child profiles and noted that one profile lists a severe allergy. The profile indicates that the allergy does not require the administration of an EpiPen. An EpiPen is currently stored in the child's classroom for emergency use in case of an allergic reaction. The operator must request an updated child profile and obtain signed parental consent to ensure the file reflects the most current medication information and that a signed parental consent for the use of this medication is placed in the child's file.

Comments: Inspector verifies the monthly fire drills and observes that none have been completed for the month of November. Operator is to complete 1 fire drill within the next week and another one at the end of Decembre. An operator of a licensed facility must ensure to carry out emergency evacuation and fire drills monthly.

Comments: Inspector verifies the monthly review and maintenance plan for the stationary equipment and observes that none have been completed for the month of November. <p>Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection and observes in the morning within the infant group, educators were taking photos of the children in a Christmas-themed decorated box, preschool children actively listened to a story while others free play with a variety of objects on a table.</p> <p>Senior toddlers participated in a Christmas arts and crafts activity, with educators actively leading and engaging with the children.</p> <p>The inspector also observes lunch being served in accordance with the menu provided to parents, followed by quiet story time and nap periods for infants and preschool children. Children who did not nap were offered a choice of quiet activities to do on their nap mats</p> <p>Discussions with the operator for the children profile led to recommendations that all children's profiles be reviewed and updated to ensure accuracy with all information pertaining to health, particularly for those who have been enrolled since infancy.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the renewal inspection.</p>
