<p>Comments: While verifying staff members records, it was observed that one staff member's file was missing the 30-hour curriculum training certificate. The administrator must ensure that all files are kept up to date. <p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site mid-morning to conduct a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The following elements were observed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Staff members records - Qualification and training - Checks - Child guidance - Storage space <p>During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed transitions throughout the day, such as preparing to go outside and outdoor play. The Monitor also observed a classroom with an ant farm. The administrator explained that the children are collecting ants from outdoors and are learning about responsibility by understanding that the ants need to be released back into their natural environment after a few days. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed lunchtime, where a rice bowl was served, as well as the transition from lunch to nap time.</p> <p>While verifying the staff members' files, it was observed that one educator did not have their updated First Aid certificate on file. The administrator indicated that the educator has completed the course; however, the certificate has not yet been issued. The administrator must provide a copy of the certificate via email once it is</p>

received.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator about having an incubator with goose eggs during the summer. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended following Public Health guidelines. The administrator explained that the eggs are returned to the farm as soon as they hatch, and that the purpose of the activity is for children to observe the egg-hatching process.
