<p>Comments: Deficiency is now compliant</p> <p>The mandatory attendance forms are being used at the facility, but they did not reflect the appropriate numbers of children in attendance. Example – on side one, there were 26 children in the room but only 23 signed in. On side 2, there were 12 children in the room, but 15 children were signed in. The Educator for side 2 informed me it was because some of the children in his room went over "side 1".</p> <p>Educators were aware how many children were in their room at time of inspection.</p> <p>Educators were able to fix the attendance records for their class at time of inspection.</p> <p>A reminder that the attendance record for each room must correctly show how many children are present that day, for that room for safety reasons.</p>			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>Children were finishing up lunch when I arrived for today's renewal inspection. After lunch was finished, children from "Side 1" were observed playing group activity games, those who did wish to participate were able to play with materials of their choice, such as reading books, stuffed animals, board games, Lego, etc. On "Side 2," children were observed playing with a variety of material such as dramatic play, dolls, different building block/materials, Lego, crafts.</p> <p>Once children had a sufficient amount of time to play inside, educators were observed providing children with ample warning before transitioning to outside play. Observed educators polling the children on what location they wished to play at while outside.</p> <p>Facility uses the school park right next door. While outside, children were observed playing on the play structure, rolling around snowballs to see how big they could get them, digging with shovels/sticks, and one group of children was observed making a seat out of an already constructed snowball. Educators were</p>

observed ensuring they were constantly on the move so they could properly supervise the children.

Child-staff ratio was observed to be maintained at all times in both rooms.

The facility's indoor environment offers a very clean and welcoming atmosphere for the children to thrive in. Both school age classrooms have an abundance of learning materials that meet the interests of the children.

Educators were observed being attentive to the children during a time of inspection.
