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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon the arrival of licensing staff, children were observed playing outdoors in the schoolyard, exploring the snow. All children were appropriately dressed in winter gear, and educators were actively supervising the group. First aid kits were brought outside as required.</p> <p>During outdoor play, the inspector reviewed staff and child files, all of which were found to be compliant. Fire evacuation drills had been completed; however, they were not documented on the designated form for this license. A reminder was provided to ensure that each drill is properly recorded moving forward.</p> <p>After spending time outdoors, the groups transitioned indoors. Once children removed their outdoor clothing, they gathered on the mat while the educator outlined plans for the remainder of the afternoon. Children were then given the choice to engage in free play or have a snack. Observed activities included building with Lego, playing chess, exploring the dramatic play area, creating arts and crafts, and relaxing in the reading corner.</p> <p>The second group was observed sitting in a circle on the mat while an educator read a book aloud. During this time, one child became upset following a minor incident. The educator responded promptly, offering gentle and attentive care to meet the child's needs. While the reading continued, another educator prepared engaging play invitations for the group, including a craft activity where children could design and build their own snow village. Some children engaged in this activity while others ate snack or played with Legos.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed throughout the visit.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.</p>
