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General Comments

Renewal Inspection:

During the inspection, a variety of developmentally appropriate activities were observed. Programming included Alphabet Bingo, Walk Like a Chicken, and cutting activities using scissors. The Operator shared that there is a strong focus on fine motor skill development, which was reflected in both the planned activities and available materials.

Outdoor experiences observed included water play, sand play, use of the swings, garden exploration, and observing bugs and snails. These activities supported physical development, sensory exploration, and engagement with the natural environment.

Hand washing routines and snack time were observed as part of the daily care practices.

The indoor and outdoor environments were set up with a wide range of materials to support ongoing learning experiences. The Operator shared that current programming is focused on Spring, with activities such as planting flowers and vegetables, exploring nature, observing bugs, and engaging with puddles and mud. The Operator noted a strong interest in outdoor play.

Documentation displayed throughout the facility reflects current learning and program planning, including learning stories, planning webs, photographs of experiences, observations, and family books to support a smooth transition for new children entering day care.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, infant toddler daily sheets, nap sheets, and daily attendance sheets.

The Operator's, associated person, and all child files were reviewed.

The facility is recommended for licensing.
