Comments: Inspector observed that fencing was missing and detached in the outdoor play area. Educator indicated that they are in the process of repairing the fence. Inspector advised that the fencing requires repair.

Comments: Inspector observed a hot beverage on a shelf in the hallway. No beverages are permitted in the areas that are occupied by the children. The beverage was placed in the kitchen away from the children.Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector observed bottles without a label and advised the educator on site that labels with the children names are required.

Covid-19 recovery phase recommendations:

Inspector recommended that the cleaning records include the staff names\initials. The cleaning records noted Page 1 of 2

that the toys are only cleaned once daily. The educator stated that the toys are cleaned twice a day and that it will be added to the daily cleaning records. Inspector observed that the potty chair requires cleaning. The inspector were not thoroughly screened prior to entering the facility. The educator did take the temperature of the inspector but failed to ask every screening questions. The screener is required to record the following when an individual enters the facility: name, phone number, date and time of arrival and date and time of departure.

Inspector observed that there were a lack of toys in the centre. The director indicated that several toys were removed due to Covid-19. It was recommended to reassess the quantity of toys that are stored away in order to add more to the play areas to accommodate the increasing number of children attending the daycare.

The above mentioned Covid-19 recommendations are required to be implemented by July 21, 2020.

Inspector observed positive interaction between the educators and the children. The educators were very engaged in the activities with the children. The inspector observed the educator serving a meal while practicing Covid-19 safety measure such as wearing a mask and washing his hands prior to preparing the meals.
