Comments: Three children were not marked out with the times entered in the attendance forms over the last week. Every child must be marked in and out with the time each day.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jun 01, 2021	
Comments: Outdoor play area must have any broken or cracked toys with sharp pieces removed. Inspector notes a broken ride on Disney toy with a sharp piece on the front, a broken basketball hoop, and several other toys with cracks or broken pieces which are sharp. There is also a fabric baby bouncer chair which is ripped and must be removed as it cannot be properly cleaned.

Comments: First aid kit is complete, but antiseptic wipes are expired and must be replaced.

Comments: Two child profiles are missing immunization records. All children must have immunization records in their child profiles prior to beginning at the facility.			
48(6) An operator of a licensed facility shall post information relating to any allergies of the children in the food preparation area.	48(6)	May 31, 2021	
Comments: Two child profiles had noted minor allergies/intolerances on their profiles. These should be listed in the food preparation area.

Inspector observed children engaged in play both outside and inside the center.
 Inspector notes that child profiles contain transportation consents but that no transportation is offered at this time.
 All protocols for Covid-19 yellow phase were met during this inspection.
