The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the visit, the followings were verified: - Staff record files - Outdoor play area and outdoor play area material and equipment - Ratio and maximum number of children.							
During the visit, children ate snack and played outdoors. Positive interaction between staff and children were also observed.							
The Quality Assurance Monitor and the operator had a discussion regarding toys being on the ground in the outdoor play area. To ensure safety and an area free of hazards, the QAM recommends a cleanup. The operator informs the QAM that she purchased storage bins, and an outdoor play area cleanup will occur sooner than later.
