The Quality Assurance Monitor arrived at the facility during naptime. The child-to-staff ratio was not respected. Only one educator was present with 5 preschool children and 3 infants while the other educators left the premises for their lunch breaks. 1) Both groups were left without direct supervision. The educator present could not be in 2 classrooms at once. The child-to-staff ratio for children in a group may be reduced by one-half for napping children; however, that one staff member must be present in the same room as the children. 2) During lunch breaks when children are napping, staff members included in the child-to-staff ratio must remain on-site and must be easily accessible within the building. 3) Even though preschool children and infants were in two separate classrooms during naptime, only one educator was present for their care. Preschool children and infants are not to be mixed outside of 8:30am to 4:30 pm. Both groups need their own educator. The educator on site contacted the operator. After 15 minutes, 2 more educators arrived. To ensure adequate supervision, the operator must ensure that child-to-staff ratio is respected at all times despite the few exceptions.

General Comments

All required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. Parents and staff members are well informed of important information regarding the operation of the facility.

The facility has a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for toxic products, chemical products, cleaning supplies and medications.

The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe naptime and indoor play. A discussion with the operator was had regarding medications administered in cases of anaphylactic shock. The QAM confirmed to operator that Epipens must not be stored in a locked space but must be inaccessible to children.
