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General Comments The children were engaged in some free play activities when I arrived. As the operator prepared the morning snack, which consisted of toast, peanut butter, apples and milk, the children got their scrap books out and started to draw. After snack the children went outside where they rode bikes on the grass and hung out in the fort where they played on the swing and looked for insects and worms, by flipping some of the tires over. They decided to go for a walk to the school playground to play on the slide, monkey bars and climbing structure. As it got close to lunch time they headed back to the house, on the way back they noticed some animal footprints in the mud. Some of the tracks were from birds and other tracks according to the children could be a "dog", "wolf" or "coyote". As the operator prepared lunch some of the children played dentist as one child had gone to the dentist that morning. Other children watched the birds eating out of the bird feeder as the operator has a camera set up to see what kind of birds eat at the feeder. The operator advised me that is doing a book study on three books. "The Little Guys", "Good dog Carl" and "Tuesday". They are all picture books, so is interested to see how the study will go. There are a variety of materials both inside and out for the children to learn and explore with. The operator follows the interests of the children. She does this by asking them questions of what they would like to do. During the visit, positive child guidance techniques were observed. When needed the operator would get down to eye level of the child to talk with them. She offered gentle reminders and encouragement, advising the children to use their words when they get discouraged or upset. The children seem very comfortable in the environment and are familiar with the daily routine.
