General Comments						
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were finishing quiet time. To avoid waking up the other classes, the 3-year-old class went downstairs as they woke up early from their nap. Once the younger classes were awake, the 3-year-old children lined up, got their water bottles and walked upstairs to their classroom to prepare for afternoon snack. Proper hand washing was observed before the classes sat down for snack. As the children finished eating, the Educators were observed applying sunscreen on the children. In one room, an Educator sat with a small group of children and read "I love you through and through" as they waited for their peers to finish eating. Downstairs in the 4- & 5-year-old-class the children packed up their personal belongings before lining up. The Educator played a game of "What animal am I thinking of" to keep the children engaged until they were ready to transition outside. A headcount was observed before the class went outside. The classrooms were bright, welcoming and tidy. Quotes from the children, current learning stories, webbing, family pictures and purposeful planning was observed in all classrooms. The Educators were actively engaged with the children this afternoon. They were observed sitting and reading stories with the children, laughing, smiling and playing games. The outdoor play area offers a variety of play materials for the children to use such as buckets, shovels, water tables, trucks and balls. More sand has been ordered for the infant and preschool outdoor play space.
