General Comments

- Mid day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- During the visit, ratio child-to-staff is maintained and respected in the same age and mixed age groups
- During the visit, it was observed that educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations.
- All staff files contain required checks and documentation
- Children's indoor play area is safe and clean
- In all rooms, evidence of purposeful planning based on children's interest and learning, webbing, invitation, photos and learning stories were posted.
- Material and equipment proposed to children in the indoor play area are easily accessible on low, open shelves. It is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- The administrator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate
- Daily incident log is maintained, parents are advised and signs the daily log
- Incident report forms are completed and signed by the parent when in need to fill a reportable incident. The report is sent to the Department within 24hours following the incident and a copy is given to the parent.
- Incident reports are maintained in the child's file
- Each napping child has a cot that is appropriate for their height
- Cot are stored so there is no contact with another napping equipment
- When arriving at the center, the front door was locked. There seems to be an issue with the digital lock, until it is fixed, it was suggested to post a sign with the daycare phone number on the front door.

Observations: When arriving at the center, the three's and the four's were practicing their songs for graduation staff have noticed that it helps them to be less anxious when they practice early in the year. All groups were getting ready for lunch, once they were done eating different stations were put up in the four-year-old room, following patterns with blocs, letter tracing with bingo chips, Play-Doh, Legos, puppets, and train tracks. The upstairs three-year-old group was getting ready for some friends to go to sleep while the others were transitioning into a quiet time. The downstairs preschool room were into free play while getting ready to go home, some were playing in sand, some were playing with letters, Legos and drawing.
