Visited the facility to complete annual renewal inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit. A reminder was given to educators to rake the pea gravel at the bottom of the slide to ensure that there is enough protective surfacing. Educators informed me that more pea gravel is to be added in the next few weeks as the contractor was in and measured the space.

A discussion was also had with educators regarding the completion of professional learning hours. Educators are on track to have necessary PL hours completed by the licence expiry date of July. A copy of PL hours record will be sent to inspection once they are completed.

General Comments

During the visit, preschool children were observed in free play, having lunch, participating in a group activity and playing in the outdoor play area. The school aged children arrived by bus and proceed to the outdoor play area.
