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General Comments
-Mid-day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected during the visit -When acetaminophen or medicine is administered to a child, the consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file. -Medication is locked in the administrator's office and inaccessible to children -Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EPIPEN) are easy to access for staff, but stored safely (inaccessible to children) in the classroom that is designated to the child -During the visit, it was observed that children are guided through discussion. Requests are made respectfully, and staff supports the children when conflicts arise, supporting them in reaching a mutually agreeable resolution. -Allergy information on any child is posted in the food preparation area -Drinking water is provided throughout the day -Food brought from home is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated or has an ice pack as required -A first-aid kit and a telephone are available on-site, as well as during excursions outside of the daycare premises. -Outdoor material is varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards -It is recommended that an appropriate protective surfacing be added around the play structure located in the rear playground area to enhance safety and comply with applicable playground safety standards. -The four-year-old made friendship bracelet this morning and exchanged them. The programming of the week shows activity in preparation for school that starts in a couple of days. -This week three-year-old room is exploring color mixing; programming is posted on the white board when entering the room. Observations: When arriving at the center the afterschool children were coming in for lunch time. The four's were at the ball field when arriving they washed their hands and transitioned to lunch time. The three's ate their lunch and transitioned to a free play period.
