Comments: The outdoor play area is in need of repairs and care. There is a plastic play structure house that is dismantled in a pile within the outdoor play area. It has nails exposed and is collecting standing water. To be removed immediately. One of the gymnastics rings has broken off of chain, in need of repair. Tire swing is broken, in need of repair. Two of the three picnic tales are in need of repairs. There are boards rotting on table and seat and nails poking out of the seats. Discontinue use until repairs are complete. There was garbage, wrappers, and disposable masks observed on the ground within the play area today, to be cleaned up. Educators need to monitor this daily. There are boards rotting on the bottom of play structure with yellow slide. Boards on bottom side of this structure (opposite of building), have rusty nails exposed.

Some books can be stored away, however, there must be books out and accessible daily. The foosball table on the red group's side was not accessible as there is another broken foosball table being stored on top of it. Broken table to be removed.

Some materials related to the children's interests had been set out on tables for the children's arrival today. Many board games and art supplies were set out within bags. Ensure that invitations for the children are purposeful, and related to their current interests. These should be set up in a way that is inviting to the children. (ex: setting up a board game so that pieces are out of the box and ready to go and setting out open ended art supplies on the table).

The children were engaged in creative art, building structures, and playing hockey with a model piece of ice they had previously created. The children were observed working on their hockey ice structure today, adding pieces and then playing with tiny hockey sticks for props. What else could be added to the environment to support or extend this interest?

General Comments

Educator was observed speaking to the children in a respectful, and kind nature and modelling positive child guidance strategies.

Some photos of the children were posted within the room, but were from the winter months. Ensure posted documentation is current. Recommending to create a binder to file older photos, and documentation each time this is replaced.
