A variety of large loose parts are available in the outside play areas for the children to create structures and use their imagination during play. Recommending that the metal climbing structure in the school-age outside play area have more mulch added once all the snow/ice has melted.						
iscussed with educators water tables and ensuring these are cleaned after each use. Recommending that uring nap/quite time they are emptied and cleaned and refilled if they will be using them in the afternoon. New ublic Health Guidelines were released this week and recommending that all staff are aware of the changes and additions.
