A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed both inside and outside. Baby Room - the babies were getting ready for their snack at QAM's arrival. Children were observed sitting at their snack table, eating, waving, and babbling. Educators were engaged with the children, down on their level, responding to their wants and needs. 2's - The two-year-olds were observed during outside play. Children were very interested in the outdoor mud kitchen, and toy vehicles. Children's artwork was displayed throughout the classroom, and several learning stories were also observed. 3's - The three-year-olds were on a walk during today's Monitoring Inspection. Inside the 3-year-old room, several learning stories were observed - Rain Walk, Nature, Baseball Field Fun, and Sibling Love. 4's - The four-year-olds were observed lined up, getting ready to walk to the blue bins, with some recycling. The 4's were also observed during outside play. Children were very interested in the mud kitchen and riding their Plasma Bikes. School Aged Group - children were observed playing outside, in and around their homemade tire fort. While inside, children were observed building in the block centre. Current interests include The Titanic - several Titanic themed books and Titanic documentation were observed. Children's artwork was displayed throughout the classroom, and several learning stories were also observed.
