Durning renewal inspection it was observed in the infant (0-23months) room, during nap time one educator supervising four children. One child was under 0-14months. Children 0-14 months must be supervised at all times, even during nap time. Discussed with administrator when observed. Administrator rectified immediately by having the educator come back into ratio to ensure child-to-staff ratio was being maintained at all times.

Deficiency is now compliant.

General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today. Children were observed in various areas of play both inside and outside. The classrooms were set up with age-appropriate toys and materials. The educators were observed engaged in meaningful conversations as well as playing with the children.

Hand washing and diaper changing was observed.

All staff files and random review of children's files were completed.

The educators showed that they valued the children as they were able to leave their play materials as is on the carpets for when they returned from the outdoors.

During inspection the inspector discussed with operator section 8.1.4 of the Operators manual.

To ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, the child-to staff ratio must be maintained:

- *During the operating hours of the facility
- *During arrival/departure times and during staff lunch breaks
- *During outdoor play
- *At all times (even nap time) for children younger than 15 months of age.

Inspector also discussed having a signed consent form for on-going medication for the Aquaphor Healing Balm stick for one child.
