Comments: Inspector observed in the younger school-age room numerous cans of wall paint on the stage in the school- age room. Discussed with Administrator during the inspection and these were removed and stored in a locked closet. Deficiency is now compliant.							
General Comments							
A monitoring inspection occurred today. Attendance records in all rooms as well as the daily information sheets in the infant room was reviewed and verified complete. Upon arrival at the childcare facility, the inspector observed the 2-year-old children outside in the fenced in play area, the younger school-aged children preparing for outside play, the infant group playing in their indoor learning environment with their educators, the 3-year-old group and the 4-year-old group having morning snack then preparing for outside play. In the younger school age room, the Inspector observed documentation on the wall of what the children would like to do, their "bucket list" of activities for the summer. Some of the children's ideas were water balloons, pool, and Snow's for ice cream. Documentation on the walls was also observed of the children engaged in activities such as planting a garden, outside play with water, outdoor picnic, painting activities, field trips for ice cream. and samples of mark making by the children. Children were also observed riding plasma cars, playing with cars/trucks, digging in the dirt, playing with the mud kitchen and interacting with their peers and educators.
