| <p>I saw respectful communication between educators and children, and the educators showed positive child guidance by encouraging, redirecting, and problem solving with the children.</p> <p>There are learning centres accessible throughout facility for children and they often could be seen engaging in activities and learning.</p> <p>Currently, the operators who serve as the administrators do not meet the educational requirement. Operator stated that she has been in conversation with the Director of Early Childhood. Licensing staff said she would seek clarity around the situation; however, until the understanding has been clearly defined that the Operator / administrators are meeting the educational requirement, an exemption must be submitted to the Department.
