General Comments							
Licensing staff arrived as children were seated in the cafeteria area and a petting zoo was allowing children to hold and pet rabbits. Please review the Animals and visits to farms and petting zoos section of the Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) Facilities, to ensure all guidelines are being followed in regard to animal visit to facility. Children were observed washing their hands after handling animals and an educator disinfected the tables in the area. Children then went to the gym to engage in gross motor activities. The children were all gathered in one large group on this day, ratio was maintained at all times. The older children and younger children played well together, and the activities were developmentally appropriate for all ages. Children played dodgeball, tag and mats were taken out to do gymnastics and build forts. Appropriate supervision was maintained as children created crawl spaces and forts out of mats. Children then lined up for lunch and attendance was taken. The transition to lunch was smooth. Children							
enjoyed their lunches that they brought from home while the educators provided support as needed for opening snacks.
