Comments: Licensing staff asked the Administrator if she had a purposely planned and documented program for the preschool program and she relayed to licensing staff that she has a purposely planned program however, it is not documented. Licensing staff also observed purposely planned activity centres set out for the children to engage with, but the purposely planned program needs to be documented.

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a monitoring inspection on October 26, 2022.

When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility the children were engaging in activity centres. There were five play activities set up for the children to engage in. The five centres consisted of: a playdough, dramatic play (dolls and kitchen), puzzle and cars centres.

All but one staff file was complete with all of the required documentation. Please ensure that all staff files are complete with all of the required documentation.

General Comments

All toxic materials, including cleaning supplies were stored in a cabinet secured with a lock and key.
All educators were observed engaged with the children at the child's level throughout the monitoring inspection.
The indoor play space is very clean and had an abundance of play materials accessible to the children.
