General Comments This report is written by Jenelle Hanscom Quality Assurance Monitor, Jennifer Godin was also present for this inspection. Arrived to center to perform follow up monitoring inspection, upon arrival children were transitioning to the carpet where an educator read a story. All children participated in story time. Large group activity was observed as children looked for hidden golden coins within the room. Children were very engaged and excited during this activity. Follow up discussion about how children would spend their gold was child directed and educators asked questions to build on their ideas.

General Comments

Programming was planned in advance and could be seen throughout the room within the posted artwork, sensory bins and decorations. Programming should be kept at the end of each week and available for review for a year as a form of documentation of learning experiences and inspection purposes.

Preschoolers were observed to have a strong routine which aided in transitions occurring quickly and smoothly, children were easily able to predict and anticipate what was happening throughout the day and were able to exercise a lot of independence as a result.

Room was well organized with a variety of developmentally appropriate materials available and accessible to children at all times. The educators were engaging with children and used positive behaviour guidance when needed.
