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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Classroom was clean and well organized upon arrival. Bins were labeled with both pictures and labels of which items were inside, making selection and cleaning up materials easy for children to perform independently.</p> <p>Materials offered a variety of play based learning experiences, were developmentally appropriate and assessable. Activity areas were well defined and gave space for expanding play and creating long term projects.</p> <p>Purposely planned programming and intentions for the day were posted within the classroom. Artwork and learning stories were not posted throughout the room at the time of this inspection as the centre is closing for the summer at the end of the week, however, these items were visible and posted during past visits.</p> <p>The children enjoyed a visit to Connell Park earlier in the day where they played in the splash pad. The children and educators were able to walk the distance to the park and did not require transportation.</p> <p>Children were observed participating in several activities such as board games, coloring and building with large wooden blocks and legos. Positive behaviour guidance was observed at all times and educators were on children's level, engaged in play and conversation with them. Children were given flexibility in play and brought dinosaurs and other items into their wooden structure they built which added to their imaginative play. Children moved from on activity to another at ease when they wanted.</p> |
