General Comments

The environment is set up with many learning centres and a variety of activities for the children to take part in. This includes but not exclusive to puzzles, animals, cars, dress-up, kitchen, a doll house, lego, blocks, sensory and art.

A routine has been established with the children. I witnessed transitions from free play, handwashing, lunch, group time, snack time, and outdoor time. The transitions are expected by the children and moved forward in an organized and calm fashion.

As noted on last year inspection, Professional learning hours are to be obtained during the licensing year. The inspectors will verify that a percentage of these hours are on track for all educators throughout the year. Next year hours will be observed from August 1st 2025 until July 31st, 2026. The administrator stated that she was going to complete all 10 hours during their time off this summer. These hours will be verified by the Quality Assurance Monitor in the Fall.

The children have a good rapport with the educators. Gentle reminders are used when necessary and children are redirected when necessary. One of the afterschool children was hitting a child with a ruler. One of the educators told them that they were not allowed to hit and then proceeded to show the child how to draw straight lines on paper with the ruler.

Please ensure that current files for the Operators and administrators are at both facilities. Child files were complete. File drills are being done monthly. Incident reports are being documented. A child had fallen off the monkey bars at the time of visit and hurt themselves; parents were informed and the incident was recorded.

Licensing staff can recommend facility for licensing.
