General Comments

Monitoring visit. Not all staff signed in upon arrival, but the staff corrected this during my visit. Upon arrival school age group were tidying up and getting ready to go outdoors. The school age group were excited and curious to go and check out the race cars parked in the parking lot. The Operator has been inviting people from the community to park vehicles during operational hours, so children can see them up close. They had a fire truck on site last week. All children at the centre are having an opportunity to sit in the race cars. Preschoolers are also learning about measurement. Programming posted is current and references the curriculum framework. The Operator also has a resource library set up for educators to reference. This is great!! The 2/3 classroom has built new tables. What a great way to use the small space. Children were napping upon arrival. All children with exception of school age benefit from a scheduled period of rest. Those children that do not rest the entire time are allowed to get up and play quietly. I spent most of my visit outside with school age and older preschool group. I observed new shade sails in both outdoor play spaces which provides ample shade (more than 10% as required in regulations). What a great ASP nook, which allows children to enjoy of variety of activities. All children had access to their water bottles. The only thing I would suggest is lowering the gate entering the preschool outdoor area as there is quite a gap that a small child could crawl under. Supervision is appropriate as ample staff outdoors, though the gate needs adjusted and lowered. Lots of wonderful interaction between educators and children was observed. The administrator was on site and asked me a couple of questions regarding volunteers on site. I will follow up regarding your other question.
