Comments: COVID-19 Bubble Grouping: Child from Group B was with Group A . Discussed with operator, administrator and educator, to ensure that when children arrive from school that they go into their own groupings and not into another "bubble group". This was corrected during inspection.

It is realized that one child who belonged in Group B, another "bubble group" had joined the group. This caused not only the maximum group size of 1 educator for 15 children to be exceeded but also that "Bubble groupings" under COVID-19 guidelines to be compromised. Discussed with operator, administrator and educator to ensure that children go to their own groupings and not into other groups to be with their peers.</p> <p>Corrected during inspection.</p>			

General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection was conducted today.</p> <p>Children were observed in both "bubble groupings" in snack, inside play and outside play.</p> <p>Children's art are displayed on the walls in Group A's room. The children painted on a large piece of paper a frame then they painted their own pictures in side these frames which is displayed on the wall in their room. Children in this grouping were observed engaged with art, building with magnetic blocks and playing with the doll/princess house.</p> <p>Children in Group B were observed in snack and were proudly showing off their abstract art creations that matched the creations that were painted on the windows.</p> <p>All children appeared happy and content in their environments and with their educators. The educators were observed having respectful and meaningful conversations with the children.</p>
